16	Smith Gardens Inc.	Heuchera 'Georgia Peach' Coral Bells	14"	Cream June and July	Part shade or shade	Large leaves are a bold peachy orange with a silver sheen, turning into rosy purple. Bell-shaped flowers on multiple long stems.
17	Smith Gardens Inc.	Heuchera 'Obsidian' Coral Bells	10"	White June and July	Part shade or shade	Glossy dark maroon or black leaves. Bell-shaped flowers on multiple long stems.

21	Smith Gardens Inc.	Hosta 'Blue Angel'	36"	Pale lavender Late spring and early summer	Full shade	Largest blue hosta with corrugated pointed 16" blue-green silvered leaves. More slug-resistant than most hostas. Less attractive to deer than most hostas.
22	Smith Gardens Inc.	Hosta 'Sague'	28"	Pale lavender Mid summer	Part shade or shade	Large hosta with blue-green upright leaves with creamy white on the margins
23	Smith Gardens Inc.	Hosta 'Stained Glass'	15"	Pale lavender Late summer	Part shade or shade	Midsized hosta with 10" long, bright gold leaves and wide dark green margins. Tolerates more sun than most hostas. Slightly less attractive to deer than most hostas.
24	Smith Gardens Inc.	Hosta 'Fragrant Blue'	18"	Pale lavender August	Part shade or shade	Small to mid-sized hosta with chalky, powder blue corrugated leaves that turn greener in sun or at the end of the season. More slug resistant than most hostas.

27	Smith Gardens Inc.	Iris siberica 'Caesar's Brother' Siberian iris	24"	Dark purple May	Full to part sun	Slender green foliage that turns an attractive bronze color after frost and continues to look good into winter. Tolerates moist soil.
28	Smith Gardens Inc.	Iris siberica 'Gull's Wing' Siberian Iris	34"	White June	Full to part sun	Tall arching narrow leaves. Large, semi-ruffled white blooms.
29	Smith Gardens Inc.	Iris ensata 'Lion King' Japanese Iris	36"	Purple, white Early summer	Full to part sun	Narrow deep green leaves. Very large 7-8" double flowers with small yellow accent.

33	Smith Gardens Inc.	Lavandula 'Munstead' Lavendar	20"	Lavendar Late spring, early summer	Full sun	Compact mound gray foliage. Very fragrant blue flower spikes. Blooms twice.
34	Smith Gardens Inc.	Leucanthemum 'Becky' Shasta Daisy	36"	White, yellow Mid summer to September	Full to part sun	Many 3-4" wide blooms that stand 3-4' tall and do not usually need staking.
35	Smith Gardens Inc.	Salvia 'May Night' Perennial Salvia, Garden Sage	24"	Indigo Early to late summer	Full sun	Aromatic gray-green foliage. The many tall, stiff fragrant flowering spikes stay upright.
36	Smith Gardens Inc.	Rudbeckia 'Goldstrum' Black Eyed Susan	24"	Gold, brown Mid to late summer	Full or part sun	Long-blooming and tidy. Unlike most rudbeckia, "Goldsturm" is a true perennial, getting bigger each year.
